Treasurer's Report

- We have money in our accounts
- In May, we reconciled the 2022 books
- We still have a lot of money left from the grant

Old Business

- Grant
 - Have currently spent approximately \$58,0000 out of the \$180,000
 - Appears to have enough microwave equipment that we can build out until the fall
 - Propose to move some money since we are not spending it as fast
 - Would like to put money into an interest bearing CD
 - Have approximately \$100k in checking
 - The term will be determined based on what we put in and also when the \$70,000 CD comes to terms
- Projects
 - Northeast
 - Brush, Ft. Morgan, Sterling and Akron.
 - Replace the flaky IP
 - South
 - West Creek to Cedarwood
 - John Maxwell has all the equipment already
 - Received permission to climb towers at Cheyenne Mountain

- Did have to put it under Triple C due to needing insurance.
- Have a mess at Almagre Mountain
 - WIII use grant funds due to microwave endpoint
 - Have not been there in at least 5 years.
 - Power has been down approx. 15 times in the last month.
 - Extremely difficult to access

New Business

- ARA has dissolved -
 - RMHam was contacted and asked if we would help support & keep the spirit going. Accepted provisions
 - 5 trustees that will keep 5 repeaters running for 5 years. Aka 555 Committee
 - 555 Committee will work with RMHam to keep the repeaters in working status.
 - WIII have 5k in reserve funds to support them
 - If the 5k is depleted, the RM Ham board would need to approve to replenish or take over.
 - The conditions of the repeaters are fairly old.
 - Have asked to have the repeaters be brought up to CalCon & RMHam standards
 - At the end of the 5 years, we will mutually agree what will happen with the repeaters.
