Treasurer's report

We have significant money in our accounts

The ARDC grant has been closed out, with a few projects left to complete namely "The Golden Spike"

Old Business

Doug Sharp mentioned that due to grant closeout, there will be some ongoing cleanup, additions and maintenance throughout the network but DMR is in good shape. We will be working with our partner Colorado Connection to harden a few sites, namely BaldyBreckenridge. Colcon will be spending \$3-4K to harden, we will give them \$2500 to help with the project. No objections, passes unanimously. Expanding into HF and remote operating.

Guy Hill was brought up by Doug Leber, mentioned that the site is in fair shape as grounding, tower is a mess and needs stripping. The site is owned by the Ramstetter family and we need to present the plan to them and see if they will accept. Wayne and Steve will run with this.

Summer Swapfest is coming up. Still need volunteers. Significant SK sales and other items to be sold.

Field Day scores were recovered by James Cizek from the missing FT8 log from the computer that died. He was able to massage the log and get everything cleaned up. Our score was excellent this year and a great showing. 17000 points. 13000 points in 2025.

New business

Addition of the executive committee to direct the day-to-day operations of the organization with committee financial oversight. Large expenditures will always return to the board for approval. Approved unanimously.

Election for President: Rob Wright and Glenn Reker running. Election held, Rob had 5 votes, Glenn Reker had 8 votes. Glenn becomes the new President of RMHAM replacing Rob Wright.

Wayne Heinen moved that the unopposed officers and directors be elected by acclimation. Second by Rob Wright. No opposition. Passed unanimously.
